Grass Track Racing early 20th century












THE FIRM OF JAMES FRYER, motor engineers and distributors, opened their Dragon Garage in Aubrey Street, Hereford, 50 years agon 1st February, 1908. It is therefore, perhaps not inappropriate to reproduce this picture, in which the cyclist is Mr. G. H. Butcher, M.B.E., who was at the head of the business for many years, He is seen riding on the frozen Wye at Hereford in 1917. Riding pick-a back is his second son, the late Mr. Alec Butcher, who, by a coincidence, was born on the date mentioned above—1st February, 1908. The middle one of the three other boys is Mr. Basil Butcher, Mr. G. H. Butcher's youngest son, who is now a director of James Fryer Ltd. Mr. G. H. Butcher, now retired, is in his 84th year. 













